All Parents/Carers are reminded that children should not attend school if they or anyone in their household is symptomatic or been in contact with someone showing symptoms.

Symptoms of a Covid-19 Infection

The most common symptoms are new:

- Continuous cough
- Fever/high temperature
- Loss of, or change in, sense of smell or taste (anosmia)

A new continuous cough is where you:

- Have a new cough that has lasted for an hour
- Have had 3 or more episodes of coughing in 24 hours
- Are coughing more than usual
